



What to expect

Arrival: Most groups arrive early Friday afternoons...I will typically meet you at the airport and we will stop at Cabela's in Boise to get your hunting licenses and pick up whatever you remembered on the plane that you forgot...

We'll then head to the lodge dump your stuff get a snack and go shoot a few rounds of skeet to shake the cobwebs off...

Sunday is a repeat of Saturday unless you have a flight to catch Sunday night...

Monday wakeup in time for a nice Breakfast and transport you back to the airport...Usually at this time guys book for the next year ☺ !!!
